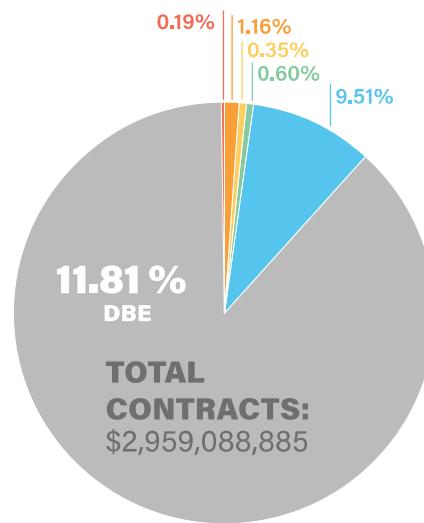


Disadvantaged Business Enterprises

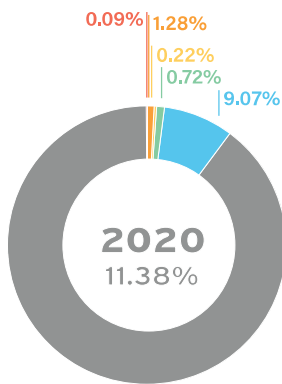

STATEWIDE TOTAL FFY 20-22

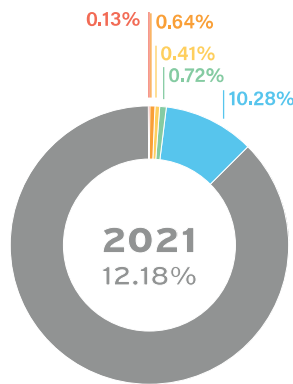

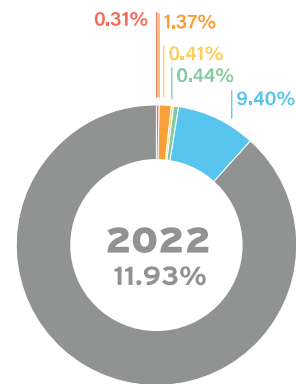
